Rules and Guidelines

This is an open competition meaning that you are allowed to submit of any genre and/or medium (abstract, realism.....oils, watercolours.....etc) presented as a drawing or painting of any subject matter (Eg. Landscape, portrait, still life etc).

Same applies to sculpture. Please no installations or videos; they will be returned to the sender.

Must be over 18.

We will accept submissions from Canada, usa and internationally.

We only accept certified checks or money orders for \$35 CAD. Please make the check payable to The Kingston School of Art entry must be received at: Salon Prize c/o CHE, 829 Norwest Road, suite 515, Kingston, Ontario, Canada, K7P 2N3 by 5:00 p.m. on the day of the 1st, Sept 2009. Confirmation will only be out via email.

Only the winners along with the artists selected for the show will be contacted by October 15, 2010.

Please no phone

calls if you have not heard from us by November 9th 2009 please send us an email to the

provided address and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

All work that is submitted must be ready for hanging should you be contacted. We will be choosing 16 people to show their work (including the winners) on location from the 9th of November to the 30th.

Board members, teachers, (including paid and non-paid individuals), and volunteers at The Kingston School Of Art are not allowed to enter.

The judges are

Please only submit work that can be easily transported and displayed. You will be responsible for getting the work to the venue.

If the work is not collected by February 1st, 2010 we reserve the right to dispose of any works still left behind.

Should we not have enough entrants refunds will be sent out to those who have submitted.

The judges' decisions are final.

The works must be done in the last 10 years. And must be submitted by artists who are still living.

Students are allowed to submit.

Please no glass slides. Glass slides and large format transparencies will not be accepted.

Artists may submit 35mm slides, or digital files in JPEG or TIFF format saved on a CD ROM or DVD ROM.

There is no limit to the number of images you submit. We will not be able to

return the slides and/or the CD's. Please be sure you have made a duplicate for your own records. Do not send the only copy of anything.

Slide Submission.

Each Slide must include the following information.

Front of slide: Must include the title of artwork, medium used to create the artwork,

dimensions (in inches with height first) and the indication of top of slide.

Back of slide: Must include artists name and address

Sculptors: must include a minimum of 2 slides of a single sculpture from different views. Combined slides for each individual artwork will be counted as one entry.

Digital submission.

Resolution: Digital images must be at least 2100 pixels in width (horizontal images)

or 2100 pixels in height (vertical images) and no larger than 3000 pixels in width or

height. Example: A digital image measuring 5 x 7 inches at 300 dpi (dots per inch) would be 1500 pixels by 2100 pixels.

File Format: Images must be in JPEG or TIFF file format (with a .jpg or .tiff extension). Save the images at a maximum quality with as little compression as possible. Files names must include the artist's name, title of artwork, dimensions (in inches with height first), and medium used to create the artwork. Example: Jim-Smith-yellow-lemons-18x6-oil-on-canvas-.jpg. Please label your cd and it is advised to send your cd in a protected clamshell or jewel case.

Entry Form - please fill out and submit the entry form on the website.

New Deadline Date for entry - September 10, 2010.

Awards will be given out at the Opening Reception.

For actual sales that occur during the show at The Kingston School Of Art--we(the school) take 20% of the sale price.

Please write NFS if the work entered and selected to be part of the show (The Salon Prize) is in a gallery during the hanging of the exhibition.
